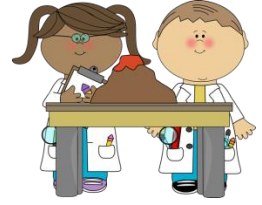


# Welcome Back

# Mrs. Harris' Student Supply List

The following list of suggested supplies will be used throughout the school year. Thank you for contributing to our classroom.

## Individual Student Supplies:

*Personal items listed below are going to be placed in student's cubby and need to be labeled with your child's name.*

- Headphones (**Please take headphones out of the package and place in a baggie labeled with your child's name. Also put your child's name directly on the headphones with a permanent marker.**) Ear buds are okay, but little ears prefer headphones. Feel free to send in the headphones you purchased last year.
- 3 **plastic**, pocket folders (with 3 hole prongs) It is important that these folders have prongs because sheet protectors organized by me will be placed inside. Please purchase the following colors: red, yellow, and blue. (**Please label inside pocket with your child's name**)
- 1 paper folder (no 3 hole prongs-any design or color-label inside pocket with your child's name)
- Plastic pencil box for your child's supplies (labeled with your child's name)
- A pair of kid scissors (remove from packaging and place in your child's pencil box)
- 1 10-pack twistable crayons (place in your child's pencil box)

## Classroom Community Supplies:

*Please do not label these items with your child's name. I will divide needed materials amongst students.*

- 10 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- (2) 4-pack/Expo Black Dry Erase Markers (fine tip)
- 1 container Clorox Wipes
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
