The following is a list of supplies that your child will need for the upcoming school year.

- \* 1 each: blue, green, and red plastic folders (2 pockets w/3 fasteners to hold papers in place) 3 folders all together (labeled with child's name) Please make these have fasteners, as I will be adding pages.
- \* Pair of children's blunt-tip scissors (labeled with child's name)
- \* 4 glue sticks
- \* 2 rolls paper towels
- \* Clorox wipes
- \* Kleenex tissues
