Suggested School Supplies for Mrs. McCamman's Class - EDUPRIZE School

LABEL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME:

- (1) box of crayons (24 count)
- (1) pair of student scissors
- (4) **BLACK, CHISEL TIPPED** EXPO Markers
- (2) glue sticks
- (1) box of no more than 12 sharpened, colored pencils
- (1) package of pencil top erasers
- (1) **PLASTIC** pencil box (8" x 5") with a snapping lid- **see picture**
(Please only get this type. No metal pencil boxes, locks, or fasteners, please.)



PLEASE PLACE THE ABOVE ITEMS IN YOUR CHILD'S PENCIL BOX BEFORE BRINGING THEM TO SCHOOL. YOU MAY PLACE ITEMS THAT DO NOT FIT INTO THE PENCIL BOX IN A ZIPLOC BAG WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON IT, WHICH I WILL STORE FOR HIM/HER.

- (1) pair of over the ear headphones (You are welcome to have your child use his/her headphones from last year, but please check them to ensure that they are still in working order. No earbuds, please.)
- (1) **wide ruled** composition notebook

PLEASE WRITE YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON A SLIP OF PAPER AND SLIDE IT INTO AN INSIDE POCKET FOR THE FOLLOWING ITEMS.

- (3) plain, **PLASTIC**, 2-pocket folders with prongs (1 red, 1 blue, 1 purple- no designs please)
- (1) 1-inch, **white** 3-ring binder w/ 2 interior pockets

DO NOT LABEL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- (12) yellow No. 2 pencils (Ticonderoga or Staples brand, please)
- (1) pack of plastic sheet protectors
- (1) ream of white copy paper
- (1) box of Kleenex
- (1) container of disinfecting wipes*
- (1) bottle of hand sanitizer*

**I realize these items may be difficult to find. Please send them in in as you can. They will go a long way in keeping our classroom clean.*
