Supplies for Mrs. Andersen's 4th Grade Class – Village 2



Each child should purchase the following supplies prior to open house.



Please label these items with your child's name

- 1/2"-1" binder with clear view front
- 1 box of crayons **or** colored pencils
- 1 box of markers (thick or thin)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 thin black Expo markers (1 per quarter)
- 1 ruler with in and cm
- 1 protractor
- 1 pencil pouch
- 3 highlighters (different colors)
- 2 notebooks (1 green, 1 any color/style)
- 4 plastic folders with prongs, heavy duty plastic (2 red, 1 blue, 1 green)
- Small, hand held pencil sharpener
- Headphones
(bring old ones if still working)

Supplies to share (no need to label)

- 1 package index cards
- 1 bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 pack of pencil cap erasers
- 2 boxes of pencils (pre-sharpened preferred)
- Clorox Wipes
