

Phase II of Reopening Schools

As we enter into the second quarter, we will begin Phase II of our reopening plan. Although all of the metrics have been met, we wanted to take a more precautionary approach to ensure the safety of our staff and students.

Beginning quarter 2, we will:

- Continue to have students dropped off no earlier than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled start time. Students will line up in a designated area, but will not be able to use this time as a recess
- Allow limited visitors/volunteers on campus. Visitors/volunteers must be pre approved and will have their temperature checked upon arrival
- Allow our specialist teachers to use shared equipment/materials. Equipment/materials will be disinfected after each class
- Allow outside treats for birthdays. However, treats must be individually packaged and follow any food allergy needs
- Resume school tours with a limited number of families per tour
- Resume junior high sports. We will follow the CAA guidelines to keep athletes safe
- Allow reusable lunch bags/boxes

We will continue to:

- Have students wash their hands multiple times throughout the day
- Have hand sanitizer readily available
- Cohort grade levels at recess/lunch
- Sanitize the classrooms daily
- Follow the facial covering mandate
- Follow a suggested flow for hallway travel
- Social distance when feasible
- Sanitize frequently touched surfaces throughout the day
