# Supplies for Miss O'Brien's 3rd Grade Class

- 1" homework binder with clear view front
- Durable headphones (O.K. to reuse from previous year) - not earbuds
- 1/4 yard of cotton fabric OR a "fat quarter" (to make headphone bag)
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons
- 1 box of markers
- 2 boxes of Crayola colored pencils\*
- 2 pairs of scissors\*
- 4 thin black Expo dry-erase markers
- 1 extra-fine black Sharpie
- 1 regular black Sharpie
- 1 wooden ruler (with in. and cm.)
- 4 zippered pencil pouches (canvas cloth preferred)\*
- 4 PLASTIC 2-pocket folders with prongs to hold 3-holed paper (red, blue, green, and yellow)
- 4 glue sticks\*
- 1 individual-sized (2oz) hand sanitizer
- 1 Large Eraser\*
- 2 Composition Books (one wide ruled, one quad ruled with grids)
