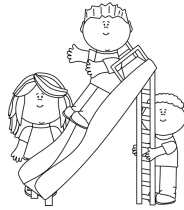
I am looking forward to the start of the year so that we may begin our journey of discovery, team building, learning, and success.

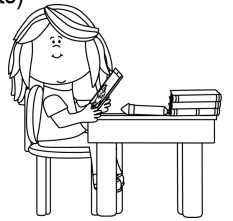
- 1" homework binder with clear view front*
