Supplies for Mrs. Andersen's

4th Grade Class

Each child should plan to bring the following supplies to open house.

Please label these items with your child's name

- 1/2" - 1" binder with clear view front
- 1 box of crayons **or** colored pencils
- 1 box of markers (thick or thin)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 4 thin black Expo markers (1 per quarter)
- 1 ruler with in and cm
- 1 protractor – half circle with angle markers
- 1 pencil pouch
- 3 highlighters (different colors)
- 3 notebooks (1 green, 2 any color/style)
- 1 quad-ruled composition notebook
- 4 plastic folders with prongs, heavy duty plastic (2 red, 1 blue, 1 green)
- Small, hand held pencil sharpener
- Headphones (bring old ones if still working)

For Specials- Zip top pencil/binder pouch labeled with your first and last name. Please fill with the following items:

- o Colored pencils and crayons (prefer Crayola brand)
- o Glue stick
- o Scissors
- o 2 Regular pencils (not a mechanical pencil)
- o Large eraser

Classroom supplies to share (no need to label)
