





Bring these supplies to Open House to get settled into your desk. Watch for the Back to School sales or visit the Dollar Store! Please do not label any of the supplies unless it specifies below.

Necessities

- (1) student scissors with pointy tip (**label**)
- (1) 1-inch 3-ring plastic view binder w/ pockets (**label on paper and slide into front**)
- (1) package of 5 dividers w/ pockets (**place inside 3-ring binder**)
- (1) clear **enclosed** pencil box no more than 2" tall (**label**)
- (1) box of **Crayola** colored pencils
- (1) box of **Crayola** bold markers
- (1) pair earbuds or headphones
- (1) small box or container to hold earbuds (mint containers work well!) (**label**)
