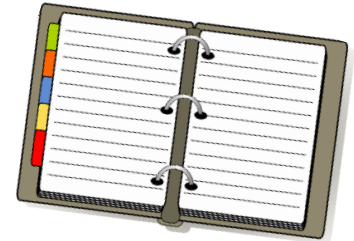

- (1) pack of PRE-SHARPENED pencils or mechanical pencils
