All students must be on-time and present the entire day to be considered enrolled at EDUPRIZE

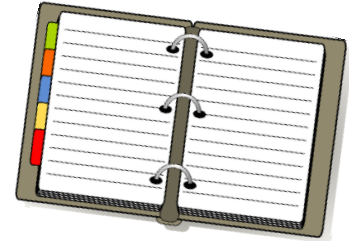
