Here are the supplies your child will need to succeed this upcoming school year. Please bring all supplies to the Open House on Monday, July 19th. This will allow me to store the supplies and have a smooth start on the first day of school. Some items will be used as a classroom set so please only label the items indicated with your child's name.

Please only put your child's name on the items indicated

- 1 Regular-sized pencil box. **(Please write your child's name)**
- 1 Pair of pointed scissors **(Please place inside of pencil box)**
- 4 2 pocket, 3-prong folders: red(1), green (1), yellow(1), and blue (1) **(Please write child's name in pen on the inside cover of the folders)**
- 3 Composition Notebooks **(Please write child's name in pen on the inside cover of the notebook)**
- 1 1-inch plastic view **heavy-duty** or **durable** binder (any color) with pockets on the inside - **(write your child's name on a slip of paper and slide it into the front)**
- 1 Quality pair of earbuds or headphones **(Please label a piece of tape with your child's name and wrap around the cord)**
- 1 Pack of glue sticks (4 count or higher)
- 1 Watercolor set- **Put your child's name on the back**
- 1 box 24 Crayola crayons (classic colors) - **Put inside the pencil box**
- 1 box Classic Markers - **Put inside the pencil box**
- 1 box Colored pencils-**Put inside the pencil box**
- 1 box Ticonderoga Pencils (sharpened if possible)
- 2 Block erasers
- 3 Broad White Board Markers (black only please)
- 2 reams White Copy Paper
- 1 Plastic Ruler (keep at home)
- 1 Backpack (No rolling backpacks please)
- 1 Re-useable water bottle
