The following is a list of supplies that your child will need for the upcoming school year.

Please label with your child's first and last name

- 1 pencil box – please buy a simple open and close type without zippers or buckles
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 1 pair over the ear headphones with a cord
- 1 durable pocket folder without fasteners- any color
- 1 primary wide ruled composition notebook- any color>>>>>



No Need to label the following supplies:

- 1 red plastic, 2-pocket folder with fasteners
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (classic colors)
- 4 jumbo glue sticks
- 1 box dixon ticonderoga pencils (if possible please pre-sharpen for us)
