**Please write your child's first and last name on the following items:**

- ★ 1 backpack (no rolling backpack please)
- ★ 1 reusable water bottle
- ★ 1 green **plastic** pocket folder with 3 prongs
- ★ 1 yellow **plastic** pocket folder with 3 prongs
- ★ 1 **plastic** pocket folder with 3 prongs (any color/style with)
- ★ 1 pair of over the ear headphones with cord (labeled with child's name)
- ★ 1 4x6 family photo to display in our classroom
- ★ 1 plastic pencil box - about 8 x 5 inches (please have it be a plain without a design, simple open and close type without zippers or buckles)
- ★ 1 pair of child scissors (label with child's name)

**These items will be community supplies and do not need to be labeled: (they will be replenished as needed)**

- ★ 1 box (24 pencils) - Dixon Ticonderoga recommended (sharpened please)
- ★ 1 box of Crayola markers thick
- ★ 2 boxes of 24 crayons (Crayola brand classic colors preferred)
- ★ 6 count box of glue sticks (Elmer's preferred)
- ★ 2 large white erasers
- ★ 1 package of pencil top erasers
- ★ 1 package (6 pack) of **thin** Expo dry erase markers (black, please)
- ★ 1 package of standard or heavy duty sheet protectors (please, no economy)
- ★ 1 ream of white copy paper
- ★ **Boys:** 1 box of Gallon Ziploc bags **and** 1 package of kleenex
