**Definitions**

**Scholarship**-accomplishing and maintaining academic excellence

**Leadership** -positions in which a student was responsible for directing or motivating others should be included (e.g., elected officer for student body, class, or club; committee chairperson; team captain; newspaper editor; work area manager; or other community leader).

**Service** - service activities are those that are done for or on behalf of others (not including family members) for which no compensation (monetary or otherwise) has been given.

**Character** - a person of character demonstrates the following six qualities; trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship

**Citizenship** – has participated in organizations which; demonstrate the importance of civic involvement, has a high regard for freedom and justice and makes students demonstrate mature participation and responsibility.
