## Open House

- ★ <u>Computer Mouse</u> in a small Ziploc bag (Wired only please) This supply is OPTIONAL If your child is comfortable with the trackpad on the computer, it is not necessary.
- ★ 1 regular-sized pencil box
- ★ 1 pointed pair of unpackaged <u>scissors</u>
- ★ 1 one-inch, solid colored <u>3-ring binder</u> with inside pockets and a clear sheet on the outside to hold a cover sheet (This will be used as a Homework/Communication Book) Please write your child's name on the inside, upper right-hand corner.

#### Please **do not** label the following items..

- ★ 2 boxes of Crayola Crayons 24 pack.
- ★ 1 blue, <u>plastic pocket folder</u> with metal fasteners
- ★ 1 red, <u>plastic pocket folder</u> (Fasteners are not necessary, but okay.)

- ★ 1 package of black, thin Expo white board markers
- ★ 1 roll of paper towels
- ★ 1 box of <u>tissues</u> (any shape)
- ★ 2 containers of <u>antibacterial wipes</u> for cleaning desks
- ★ 1 bottle of <u>hand sanitizer</u> with pump (any size)
- ★ 1 box of plastic baggies (Boys <u>sandwich</u> <u>size</u> and Girls <u>gallon size</u>)
- ★ 1 package of <u>plastic forks</u> (girls only)
- ★ 1 package of <u>plastic spoons</u> (boys only)
