Mrs. Bradley's Second Grade Suggested Supply List

Please bring these supplies with you to the Open House on Monday, July 17th. If last year's supplies are still in good shape please reuse them for this year. Thank you for contributing to our classroom. <u>Please do not put your child's</u> <u>name on anything but the items requested.</u>

- (1) pencil box (standard size, plastic, do not buy the small narrow one) Put your child's name on it
- (1) pair of pointed scissors **Put your child's name on it and put in the pencil box.**
- (1) <u>1 inch</u>, 3 ring binder with inside pockets and a clear sleeve on the outside to hold a cover sheet. <u>Put your</u> child's name on it
- o (8) glue sticks
- (2) boxes of 24 crayons <u>Put your child's name on them (put one in the pencil box)</u>
- o (1) packages of Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (standard color, sharpened) (Put 2 in your child's pencil box)
- \circ (2) reams of white copy paper
- o (2) packages of 4 low odor fine-tip dry erase markers (Put one in your child's pencil box)
- (1) package of sheet protectors
- o (1) red and yellow wide ruled composition notebooks (No names on them)
- \circ 1 Box of tissues
- o 1 set of inexpensive headphones (Please of possible, no earbuds) Put your child's name on them
- o 2 Rolls of paper towels

Daily: students need a backpack and a water bottle. Please make sure that their name is on both items. Make sure the backpack is big enough to fit their 3 ring binder in. **Please do not bring these to Open House.**
