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Supply List

The following items are supplies that your child will be using in class for the 2023-2024 school year. Any extra supplies from your student will be put in a Ziploc bag with your student's name on it.

- 4 pocket folders with prongs Yellow, Blue, Green and Orange (plastic last longer)
- 1- PLASTIC 2 pocket folder for homework folder.
- 2 lined paged composition notebook-(non-spiral) *plain covered not plastic cover*
- 1 pencil box (large enough to fit crayons, glue, scissors etc. Can use last years)
- 1 pack of crayons

- 1 pair of scissors (can use last year's scissors)



- 1 pack glue sticks (4 pack or more. We go through 100's of these per year)
- 1 pack #2 pencils
- Headphones
- 2 reams printer paper
- 1 pkg (4 at least) Dry erase markers (Expo work the best and last the longest, 1 per quarter) They go through more. I save these with your child's name on it.

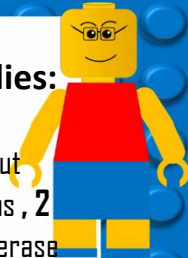
- Boys Kleenex

A message about supplies:



Students ahead of time can put scissors, 1 glue stick, crayons, 2 sharpened pencils, and 1 dry erase marker in their pencil box.
