Eagle Day

Eagle Day Attendance is required to:

- -drop off your child's medication to the nurse
- -pick up your student's temporary school ID, which is required for 22/23
- -pick up carpool lane assignment
- -complete a schedule change form, if needed

#3 School ID Distribution

Pick up your temporary ID for the 22-23 school year. Permanent IDs will be issued on picture day.

#4 Lunch Program

Payment for enrollment in our lunch program is done quarterly and can only be paid online. Lunch fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.

#5 Car Lane Assignment

Receive your car lane assignment for student dropoff and pickup.

#6 Schedule Q&A

Our director of student services and academic counselor will be available to answer questions about your student's schedule. Schedule change requests may be submitted but will not be completed at Eagle Day.

#7 Sports Information

Athletic Director will be available to answer any questions. Sports fees and which sport are in season.

#8 Chromebook distribution for 7-12 graders who have signed the online agreement. Please sign **prior** to eagle day for quick turnaround time. Instructions are located <u>here</u>.

Driving students: Please visit the B3 front desk to apply for a parking permit

Student drivers must register their vehicle with EDUPRIZE High School beforehand. In order to register your vehicle, you must bring a copy of a valid driver's license, registration, and vehicle insurance to apply for a parking spot.

B3 Nurse office: Our school nurse will be available to answer any questions and collect medication.

Eagle Day Times

7th Grade: 8-10 am 9th-10th Grade: 1-2 pm

8th Grade: 10-12 pm 11th-12th Grade: 2-3 pm

7th and 8th grade families are welcome to visit their teachers in building 3.

Teachers will not be available from 12-1 pm.

EDUPRIZE EAGLE DAY STUDENT FEES: All fees are Non-refundable and Non-transferable.

Eagle Pack \$70 is due and payable at the Eagle Days or before the first day of school:

- 1. **7th 12th Grades** (Eagle Pack includes Elective Fee*, ID and Agenda or EVIT Transport Fee)
- 2. *For those attending EVIT, the Eagle Pack covers the Transportation Fee of \$70.00 (which covers transportation from EDUPRIZE campus to EVIT Mesa campus at 11:35). Note: EVIT students do not pay for Electives.

Life Fund \$75, if not yet paid, is due and payable at Eagle Days (this offsets Field Trip transportation costs and entrance fees).

9th-12th Grade PE Uniforms - Shirts \$13. Shorts \$13

- All High School PE students will be required to change into athletic clothing and appropriate shoes for their PE class.
- Pay this fee with the other student fees but your PE uniform will be distributed through your advisory teacher. It will take 3-5 days to get the uniforms to students after the first day of school.
- Note: 7th and 8th grade PE students do not dress out but do need to wear appropriate footwear.

If you cannot attend Eagle Day on the 14th, the following limited alternatives are available:

Carpool lane assignments and student IDs can be picked up at the B3 front desk between 8-11 and 12-3 on Monday July 17th. Anything not picked up on the 17th will be distributed in advisory class.

Chromebooks that are not picked up during Eagle Day will be distributed in advisory classes the first week (all paperwork must be complete).

Schedule change forms can be obtained and submitted online.

Please note that the B3 front desk will be closed for training the 18th and not available to distribute items.

• First Day of School is Wednesday, July 19th

- Students must be present and on time on the full first day to be considered enrolled.
- No cell phones are permitted during school hours.
- All students will need an ID to move between buildings.
- Before the starting bell:
 All Secondary students assemble on the courtyard east of Building 3.
- School starting bell rings at 7:48 am
- Student schedules are online through Infinite Campus. Print if you would like a hard copy.
- 7th & 8th ends at 3:10 pm, except for Friday Early Release
- 9th -12th ends at 3:20 pm, except for Friday Early Release
- First day of school is Block Schedule 'A' Day for 9th-12th
