IB Registration

Most of the students planning to take an IB test in May have been registered this week (I'm waiting on some additional information for a small number of students). On Friday, they received a receipt of payment that contains the test(s) they have been registered for as well as their personal code (they will need this to access the results). Each test is S119 and needs to be paid through Infinite Campus and the "school store" link. I also put specific instructions on the "All Things IB" Google Classroom page if there is any confusion about how to pay. All payments are due by Friday, October 13th.

IB ELA "Across the Curriculum" Initiative

EDUPRIZE has been selected to pilot a program for IB. This program encourages students who would not normally consider enrollment in IB ELA to enroll. Currently, we have a team of teachers and administrators working together to figure out how this will look for our school. We are also working with an IB district level coordinator who has already implemented this at her school. The goal is to reach the appropriate level of rigor for more students and to expand our program. This course will be offered as a one year ELA course (not a two year course as is currently the case).

IB Day of Service

First semester IB Day of Service will be Wednesday, November 8th from 8-3. During this day, IB juniors and seniors will help around our campus with a variety of activities that teachers and administrators request. This is a great time for IB students to demonstrate their learner profile traits and to help out our school community. Stay tuned for more information and pictures of the fun day.



Health Office Updates

IMPORTANT HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION

As illness or health situations occur throughout the school year, it may be necessary for medication to be administered at school. All prescribed AND over the counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc.) will need to be checked into the Health Office, along with a <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form which requires a doctor's signature. These forms can be found on our website <u>www.eduprizeschools.net</u> under the Parent & Student Resources>Health Office Forms, or you can just click on any of the links provided in light blue.

- <u>HEALTH ACTION PLAN</u>: Please be aware that children who have asthma, diabetes, or seizures will need an action plan provided by their health care provider, ALONG with the signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ASTHMA</u>: If your child has asthma, an asthma action plan will need to be provided by your doctor ALONG with a signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ALLERGIES</u>: Allergies that require an EpiPen will need an <u>Anaphylaxis Management Packet</u> filled out and signed by a doctor along with the <u>Prescription and Non-prescription</u> <u>Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>MEDICATION</u>: As a reminder, ALL medications need to be checked in at the Health Office. Students should not carry medications in their backpacks. A <u>Prescription and Non-</u> <u>prescription Medication Consent</u> form will also need to be filled out for any medications, prescription or non prescription.

We cannot accept ANY medications without these forms. Any questions can be directed to the Health Office staff at (480) 813-9537 option 7
