Dear EDUPRIZE Parents,



I have some GREAT news to share with you: The Arizona Department of Education has **Robin Yeargain** released the school letter grades for the 2022-2023 school year and EDUPRIZE has been awarded an A rating once again! This is a huge achievement that confirms the amazing things happening on our campus!

There is always some confusion with the school letter grade from the Arizona Department of Education and our A+ School of Excellence award. The school letter grade is based on AASA test scores for students in grades 3-8. This grade indicates a distinguished performance on the statewide assessment, significant student growth, students on track to proficiency, and overall performance is significantly higher than the state average. We are also awarded bonus points for science performance and special education growth.

The A+ School of Excellence is awarded to schools that go above and beyond the everyday practices that all schools are expected to implement. A+ schools model quality and equity, demonstrate a strong commitment to academic excellence, and cultivate learning-centered and safe school environments. This program is voluntary and requires schools to apply through an application process. If chosen, the school then hosts a visit from the A+ committee, where they observe and collect a variety of data to determine if a school will be awarded the A+ School of Excellence. Schools retain the award for four years and then need to reapply. We have received this honor 5 times, with the last award given in 2022!

These accolades are not the accomplishment of an individual person, but the combined effort of every single person on this campus. None of this would be possible without the entire staff helping support student growth academically and socially. Take a moment to thank the staff for ALL they do!

Health Office Updates

IMPORTANT HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION

As illness or health situations occur throughout the school year, it may be necessary for medication to be administered at school. All prescribed AND over the counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc.) will need to be checked into the Health Office, along with a <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form which requires a doctor's signature. These forms can be found on our website <u>www.eduprizeschools.net</u> under the Parent & Student Resources>Health Office Forms, or you can just click on any of the links provided in light blue.

- <u>HEALTH ACTION PLAN</u>: Please be aware that children who have asthma, diabetes, or seizures will need an action plan provided by their health care provider, ALONG with the signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ASTHMA</u>: If your child has asthma, an asthma action plan will need to be provided by your doctor ALONG with a signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ALLERGIES</u>: Allergies that require an EpiPen will need an <u>Anaphylaxis Management Packet</u> filled out and signed by a doctor along with the <u>Prescription and Non-prescription</u> <u>Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>MEDICATION</u>: As a reminder, ALL medications need to be checked in at the Health Office. Students should not carry medications in their backpacks. A <u>Prescription and Non-</u> <u>prescription Medication Consent</u> form will also need to be filled out for any medications, prescription or non prescription.

We cannot accept ANY medications without these forms. Any questions can be directed to the Health Office staff at (480) 813-9537 option 7
