## SEL CORNER (SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING)

Dear EDUPRIZE families,

For the next few weeks, I'd like to talk about student motivation. Does your child tell you (in words or actions) that they, "don't care"? The first step in targeting strategies you can use with your unmotivated child is to ask WHY the child appears unmotivated. Here are 3 likely causes:

- **Power** your child may lack the resources, the opportunity, **Dean of Stu** and/or the capability to influence the circumstances of his/her own life.
- **Models** your child may not have the background knowledge to refer to an adequate amount of examples in order to establish meaningful values, ideals, and personal standards. This means does your child actually know HOW to do the thing they are trying to do?
- **Connectedness** your child may lack a sense of belonging, closeness, or affection to people that are important to him/her.



Health Office Updates

#### **IMPORTANT HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION**

As illness or health situations occur throughout the school year, it may be necessary for medication to be administered at school. All prescribed AND over the counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc.) will need to be checked into the Health Office, along with a <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form which requires a doctor's signature. These forms can be found on our website <u>www.eduprizeschools.net</u> under the Parent & Student Resources>Health Office Forms, or you can just click on any of the links provided in light blue.

- <u>HEALTH ACTION PLAN</u>: Please be aware that children who have asthma, diabetes, or seizures will need an action plan provided by their health care provider, ALONG with the signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ASTHMA</u>: If your child has asthma, an asthma action plan will need to be provided by your doctor ALONG with a signed <u>Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>ALLERGIES</u>: Allergies that require an EpiPen will need an <u>Anaphylaxis Management Packet</u> filled out and signed by a doctor along with the <u>Prescription and Non-prescription</u> <u>Medication Consent</u> form.
- <u>MEDICATION</u>: As a reminder, ALL medications need to be checked in at the Health Office. Students should not carry medications in their backpacks. A <u>Prescription and Non-</u> <u>prescription Medication Consent</u> form will also need to be filled out for any medications, prescription or non prescription.

We cannot accept ANY medications without these forms. Any questions can be directed to the Health Office staff at (480) 813-9537 option 7
