Dear EDUPRIZE families,

Motivation part 2 - If a child lacks motivation due to a feeling of **powerlessness**, they may be: stubborn, bossy, aggressive (or withdrawn), overly frustrated, etc. Some strategies (from veteran educator Chick Moorman) that help **motivate children seeking POWER** are:

- **Giving choices** (use words like choose, decide, or pick) from a set of 2-3 options (ALL of them you are ok with) to give more control. Find opportunities to point out how your child is **ALREADY choosing** so many good things, like, "Thanks for putting your dirty plate in the dishwasher without me having to ask." And If your child is engaging in an undesired behavior, use the phrase, "**make a different choice.**"
- **Say yes!** Instead of giving a no to some things, consider saying, "Yes you can do ___ just as soon as you ____."
- To combat the "I can't" attitude, say, "If you DID know how to ____ what would you do? **ACT AS IF** you can do ___ and see how it goes."
- Last but not least, here is a link to the Love and Logic process for helping kids learn **HOW to guide kids to solve their own problems.**

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Health Office Updates



IMPORTANT HEALTH OFFICE INFORMATION

As illness or health situations occur throughout the school year, it may be necessary for medication to be administered at school. All prescribed AND over the counter medication (i.e. Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Benadryl, etc.) will need to be checked into the Health Office, along with a [Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent](#) form which requires a doctor's signature. These forms can be found on our website www.eduprizeschools.net under the Parent & Student Resources>Health Office Forms, or you can just click on any of the links provided in light blue.

- HEALTH ACTION PLAN: Please be aware that children who have asthma, diabetes, or seizures will need an action plan provided by their health care provider, ALONG with the signed [Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent](#) form .
- ASTHMA: If your child has asthma, an asthma action plan will need to be provided by your doctor ALONG with a signed [Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent](#) form .
- ALLERGIES: Allergies that require an EpiPen will need an [Anaphylaxis Management Packet](#) filled out and signed by a doctor along with the [Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent](#) form .
- MEDICATION: As a reminder, ALL medications need to be checked in at the Health Office. Students should not carry medications in their backpacks. A [Prescription and Non-prescription Medication Consent](#) form will also need to be filled out for any medications, prescription or non prescription.

We cannot accept ANY medications without these forms.
