Ms. Bellack's Student Supply List

The following supplies will be used throughout the year. I would greatly appreciate you bringing these when we meet for open house. Student supplies need to be labeled with your child's name on items or outer packaging.

Headphones- Students will keep these in their cubbies. Please bring them inside of a gallon Ziploc bag with their name on the outside. (Please no earbuds, we want them to be comfortable for our kiddos.)

(1) 1 inch Clearview binder. Please label the inside pocket with your child's first/last name.

(1) 8 pack fine point washable markers

1 wide ruled composition notebook

1 tray of watercolors

1 pair of child scissors

(2) 24 pack of crayons

3 **plastic** pocket folders (with 3 hole prongs) It is important that these folders have prongs because sheet protectors organized by me will be placed inside. Please purchase the following colors: red, yellow, and blue. **(Please label the inside pocket with your child's name.)**

(1) 18 count pre-sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga brand preferred) (keep in package)

4 pink gum erasers (keep in package)

(2) 4-pack/Expo Black Dry Erase Markers (fine tip) (keep in package to prevent markers from drying out)

(1) 6-pack Elmer's glue sticks (keep in package to prevent glue sticks from drying out)

2 black Flair Pens (keep in package to prevent pens from drying out)

20 clear sheet protectors (placed in child's binder) (no need to label)

Medium size pencil box please ensure it is clearly labeled with your child's name. (any color is fine)

1 clean metal food can for our first cottage lesson (from soup or beans)

Optional supplies

1 or 2 reams of White Copy Paper, Antibacterial Wipes for student desks, Kleenex/tissues, 2 rolls of paper towels
